### 1. COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIRED ASSIGNMENT:

The research seems to be well built. The theoretical part opens space for a quantitative study by which the student is able to fulfill the aims set at the start of the thesis. I just have two questions about things that seem somewhat unclear to me in the research setting and outcomes.

### 2. WORK WITH ACADEMIC LITERATURE:

The thesis is based on a more than sufficient amount of literature. Ms. Nožičková shows that she is capable to work with the literature in a very good manner.

### 3. CONTENT LEVEL OF WORK:

The overall content is very good. The student provides the reader with very nice theoretical part and then is able to use that theory while putting together the questionnaire that is of high standard.

### 4. FORMAL LAYOUT:

One-sentence paragraphs often occur in the thesis, what is kind of uncommon in that kind of text and it lowers heavily the overall quality of the text. The figures should have been in color, it is quite hard to distinguish different results. Otherwise the thesis seems to be right from a formal point of view.

How were the universities where the data was collected chosen? Was those just the universities where you studied or was there a particular reason for choosing them.

Why there was such an uneven number of men and women that have submitted the questionnaire? Don't you think the low number of responses from men can
