1. COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIRED ASSIGNMENT:

The thesis complies with the required assignment.

2. WORK WITH ACADEMIC LITERATURE:

The author uses sufficient number of studies on the topic, both in Czech and in English.

3. CONTENT LEVEL OF WORK:

In the theoretical part the author describes the history of Vietnam, the Czech-Vietnamese relations, the process of Vietnamese immigration to Czech Republic and the theory connected to the process of adaptation to a foreign culture. In the empirical part the author conducts a qualitative research on the problematics of adaptation process of Vietnamese immigrants in Czech Republic. Acquired data is analysed in fairly logical and consistent way, conclusions are drawn and research questions answered.

4. FORMAL LAYOUT:

There are some minor mistakes in the formal layout. The quality of the text in figures and tables could be better (fig. 1, tab. 4). There should be no numbers at the beginning of references in the bibliography section (p.44-46). The references should not be in brackets. The form of citations in the text is inconsistent (see p. 9: Černík in 1st paragraph and TOLLAROVÁ in the last one). Some paragraphs in the text are not visibly divided (see e.g. p. 16, 22). There are some minor mistakes in the use of academic English (misformulations, mistypes).

5. COOPERATION WITH SUPERVISOR:

The author consulted the thesis with supervisor on a regular basis.

SPECIFIC REMARKS AND COMMENTS ABOUT THE THESIS:

The final mark was lowered mainly because of the mistakes in the formal layout.

2. The question of research sample: What would be the ideal number of respondents? Can you answer this question in this type of research? Please explain the term "theoretical saturation" in qualitative research.
